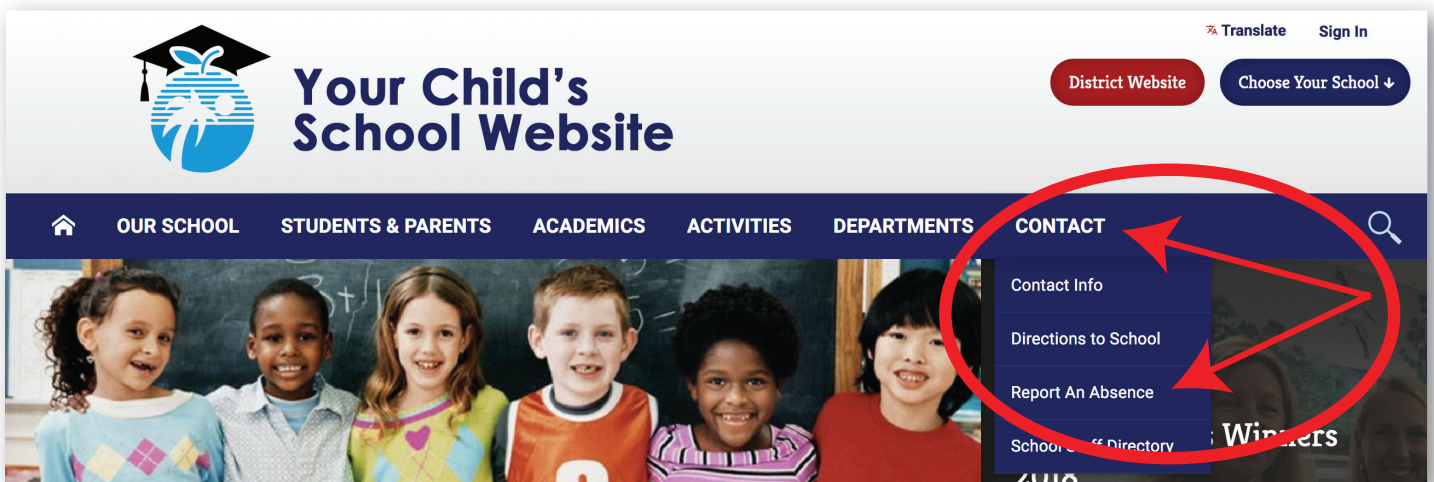




If your child is out of school, parents/guardians must report the absence. Now you can report the absence online.

From your child's school website, click on Contact, then select Report an Absence.



You can also:

- Call the school's attendance hotline
- Submit a note to the school's front office staff

The School Board of Broward County Attendance Policy 5.5 allows eight reasons for an absence to be excused:

1. Illness of student
2. Illness of an immediate family member
3. Death in the family
4. Religious holidays of the student's own faith
5. Required court appearance
6. Special event
7. Scheduled medical or dental appointment
8. Student has or is suspected of having a communicable disease
