Violation #21. Hot holding temperatures

Hot TCS food (mac & cheese and baked beans) tested 122-127F, not held at 135F or above. Reheat foods at 165F/Reheat commercial product at 135F or above. Items reheated to 147-160F

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(2). PHF/TCS foods, which are held hot and not subject to an approved HACCP plan, must be maintained at 135°F.

Violation #47. Food & non-food contact surfaces

Extensive ice buildup in reach-in freezer located in kitchen. Repair refrigerator to stop ice buildup. Work order placed.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Equipment and utensils must be properly designed, constructed, and in good repair.

Violation #55. Facilities installed, maintained, & clean

Observed black spots on A/C vents above serving area and paper storage. Clean A/C vents.

Observed hole in wall next to refrigerator in paper storage room. Repair wall.

Observed crater in floor of dry storage room. Repair floor. Work order placed.

CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, durable, easily cleanable, and non-absorbent. Exterior areas shall be kept cleaned.
