Deerfield Beach Elementary offers parent conferences multiple times a week; 7:30am or 2:30pm. Some teachers will have phone conferences with parents. In addition, Guidance offers counseling program videos for parents to check out and study. Family Nights are offered throughout the year to assist parents in learning how to improve their child's academics. Teachers send out resource information sheets to parents in interim reports and report cards on how parents can help their child develop new skills. Portfolios and work samples will be shared during school activities, conferences, and other events (throughout the school year) for parents to review their child's academic progress. Resources are also provided and posted on our school's website.
