About this Program

The Journalism program is a great fit for students who possess a strong desire to acquire knowledge regarding writing different types of articles, interviewing, publishing a school newspaper, and using social media to share school news. Students who partake in this program will be benefited in four ways. First, students will develop fundamental skills in the production of journalism across print, multimedia, web, and broadcast/radio platforms and develop knowledge of journalism history, ethics use, and management techniques related to the production of journalistic media. Second, students will help produce a publication written and fully designed by staff members of The Lariat student newsmagazine or The Roundup yearbook. Third, students will gather news, write leads and articles, take photographs, and use Adobe InDesign. Fourth, students will hone interview and research skills as well as master the craft of journalistic writing. There are multiple opportunities for students in the program to participate in leadership and competition events.
