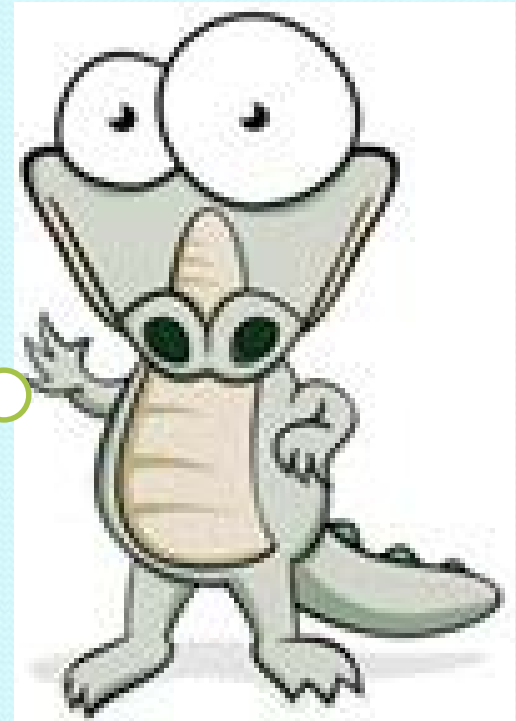

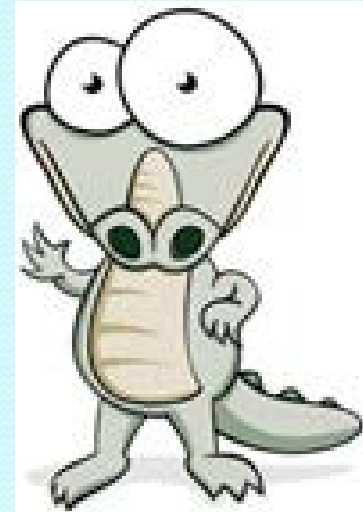

How is it accessed?

Parents/students can visit piper.browardschools.com

- **Place your cursor over the tab that says “Naviance Family Connection”**
- **Select “Naviance Family Connection Website”**



How do you register?

- All Piper High School students are already registered!
- Students can use their student ID number as their username
- Each student's password is his or her birthday, written just as follows– MM/DD/YYYY



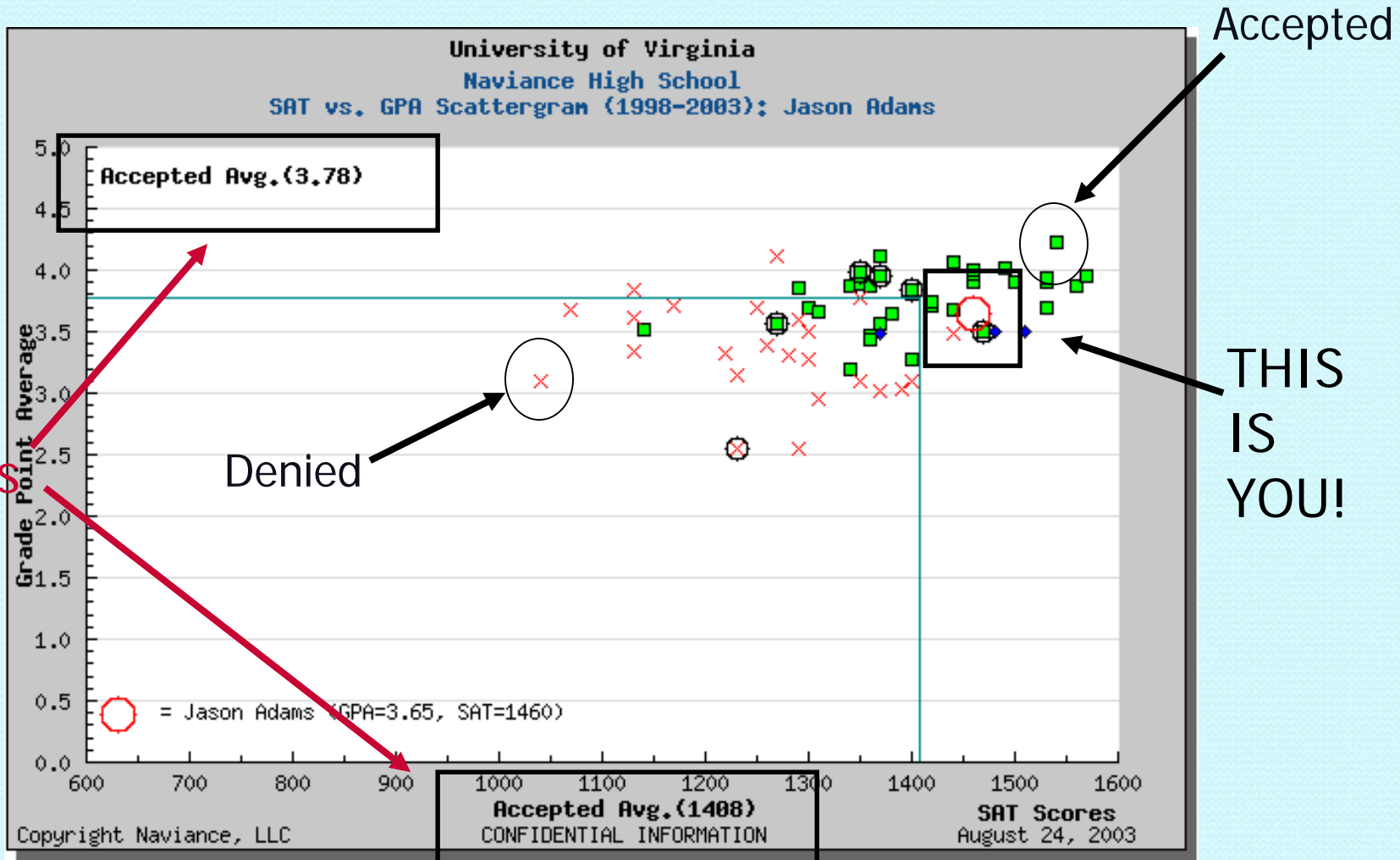
