SAC Minutes

- Meeting started at 2:25. Ms. Palacio motioned, and Mr. Horton seconded the motion.
- Norms
- Welcome
- New parent election-Stephanie Montemayer. Ms. McWhorter motioned, and Ms. Zinn seconded the motion to make Ms. Montemayer a SAC member.
- Minutes Approval-August-Ms. McWhorter motioned, and Ms. Palacio seconded the motion.
- Elections for Parent Members
- Accountability Funds: \$5,946.90-Ms. Palacio proposed a plan to target ELL students through an after school ELO camp. Teachers would be paid \$40 per day to tutor ELL students after school. The program would run 3 times per week, and we would utilize 2-3 teachers. It would run from October to Spring Break. Depending on interest, there would be a K/1, 2nd/3rd, and 4th/5th class. The camp will run from 2:15-3:15. If the interest warranted 3 teachers per week for 16 weeks, the cost of the program would be \$5,760. If the interest only warranted 2 teachers, two days per week for 16 weeks, the cost of the program would be









\$2,560. With this option, the classes will consist of K-2 and 3-5. The curriculum that will be used is the Benchmark ESOL Curriculum. Ms. McHugh motioned, and Mr. Horton seconded the motion. The SAC committee voted unanimously to use the accountability funds for the ESOL tutoring program.

- Principal Update-our teachers are all on board with students scoring 70% or better to make the mark. The PTA helped raise funds for our new sound system in the cafeteria. We are using it for many things including movies and dance parties. The PTA has asked to raise funds for a golf cart for our custodial staff. There have been updates made to our facility including new shelving in the media center, reupholstered chairs in the media center and front office, and artificial grass was donated by a local landscaping company. We are sprucing up our school to help improve our curb appeal.

The planting is tied into our curriculum. The Beach Cleanup went great.
