Details of Meeting:

Outcome of the approval process: The minutes from last meeting, September 5th have been approved.

Mr. Rivera School Updates:

- -Discusses the outcome of PM1 testing results and PM2 will be after winter break
- -Mentions the upcoming fundraiser Cougar Fun Field Day on Nov. 1st (hosted by PTA) funds raised will go towards a security booth outside by the marquee at the gate.
- -Discusses an upcoming proposal for ELO camps (ELA/Math maybe Civics) we will propose to use SAC funds (recognition/accountability) to fund the ELO camps. More coming at the November SAC meeting.
- -Praises the students who travel to Cypress Bay for the FBI program, talks about the benefits and feedback from students all is going well!
- -Mentions that Western High School has a new principal he knows the principal and has a positive relationship with the principal and this will continue to foster our school connection and relationship with Western High School.

SAF Bylaws Vote: The SAC group must vote to ratify the 2024-2025 SAF Bylaws. Ms. Silva overviews and goes through each article of the SAF bylaws with the group. Ms. Silva emailed the SAF bylaws to the group ahead of this meeting.

Discussion on Funds:

Discusses the options for how the A+ funds are being distributed. In the future at an upcoming meeting, Mr. Rivera mentioned the ELO camps proposal and Ms. Rosario will come to the group with another

proposal about an author visit. We want to welcome Christina Diaz Gonzalez, a local author, to come to our school and speak to all students. Every student reads a novel by her – per grade.

Ms. Silva discusses that SAC determines how we spend School Acct. and School Rec. funds – if anyone has any ideas or wants to bring something to the table regarding the use of these funds – please feel free to discuss.

SIP Data/Discipline – Mrs. Nissen: (Ms. Nissen absent, Ms. Henry covers)

<u>Discussion of Cognia Survey</u> – Annual survey given to students, parents, and staff – covers topics such as safety, equity, school support, wellness, and accountability.

- -<u>Safety:</u> Overall there is an overwhelming feeling of safety on campus and bullying is not an issue according to students/parents/staff.
- -Equity/Accountability: Students felt that there is adequate access to all tech and resources to learn.
- -Wellness: Students indicated that they feel supported while on campus

<u>SIP/Discipline</u> – 21 total referrals (not SESIR events). Per policy 5006, suspensions and expulsions which outlines consequences of inappropriate behavior are part of the discipline matrix. End of the year field trips are being planned for all grade levels, any misbehavior will result in removal from the trip. Students are required to wear their student ID, with their picture visible. A \$5 fine is assessed when a student requires a new ID after the 4th replacement.
