Principal's Message

Welcome to the new school year! The beginning of each year is always such an exciting time, not only for your child, but also for each teacher and administrator. We want every child, family, and school worker to know that their well-being and safety is the utmost important priority that we have! We have important safety procedures that I want to take this opportunity to share with you.

- ✓ As always, Sheridan Hills Elementary has a single point of entry in the office where the front door remains locked at all times. When entering our school for any meeting or event, it is mandatory that you **present Picture ID EVERY time you enter the school.**
- ✓ All children are allowed on campus at 7:30 a.m. No child should be dropped off prior to 7:30 a.m. as there is no supervision before that time.
- ✓ During drop off in the morning, the only entrance for your child will be the main gate between the main building and the primary building. The back gate located on the east side of the school will be locked at all times.
- ✓ During pick up in the afternoon, all students will remain inside the school. You must hang the blue car tag on your rear-view mirror with your child's name and grade clearly marked. We will call for your child and they will exit to your car.
- ✓ School fire drills and lockdown drills will continue monthly. Whenever there is a lockdown drill, you will receive a parent link phone call to keep you informed. This is one reason why it is very important that we have your correct phone number on record in the front office. If your phone numbers change during the school year, it is urgent that you update the office **ASAP!**
- ✓ All staff and students are required to wear picture ID badges each day. The student badges will remain at school with their teacher at the end of the day to prevent badges from getting lost.
- ✓ Our school qualifies for free breakfast and free lunch for every student! No paperwork is required to be completed.

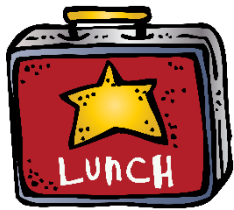
Monday, August 18th : Back To School Meet & Greet, 8:30 a.m. for Primary and 9:30 a.m. for Intermediate

Arrival & Departure

- A parent must sign out their child who requires an early dismissal **before 1:30 p.m. (11:30 a.m. on Early Release Days)**
 - Per School Board policy, all early dismissals must be completed more than 30 minutes prior to dismissal.
