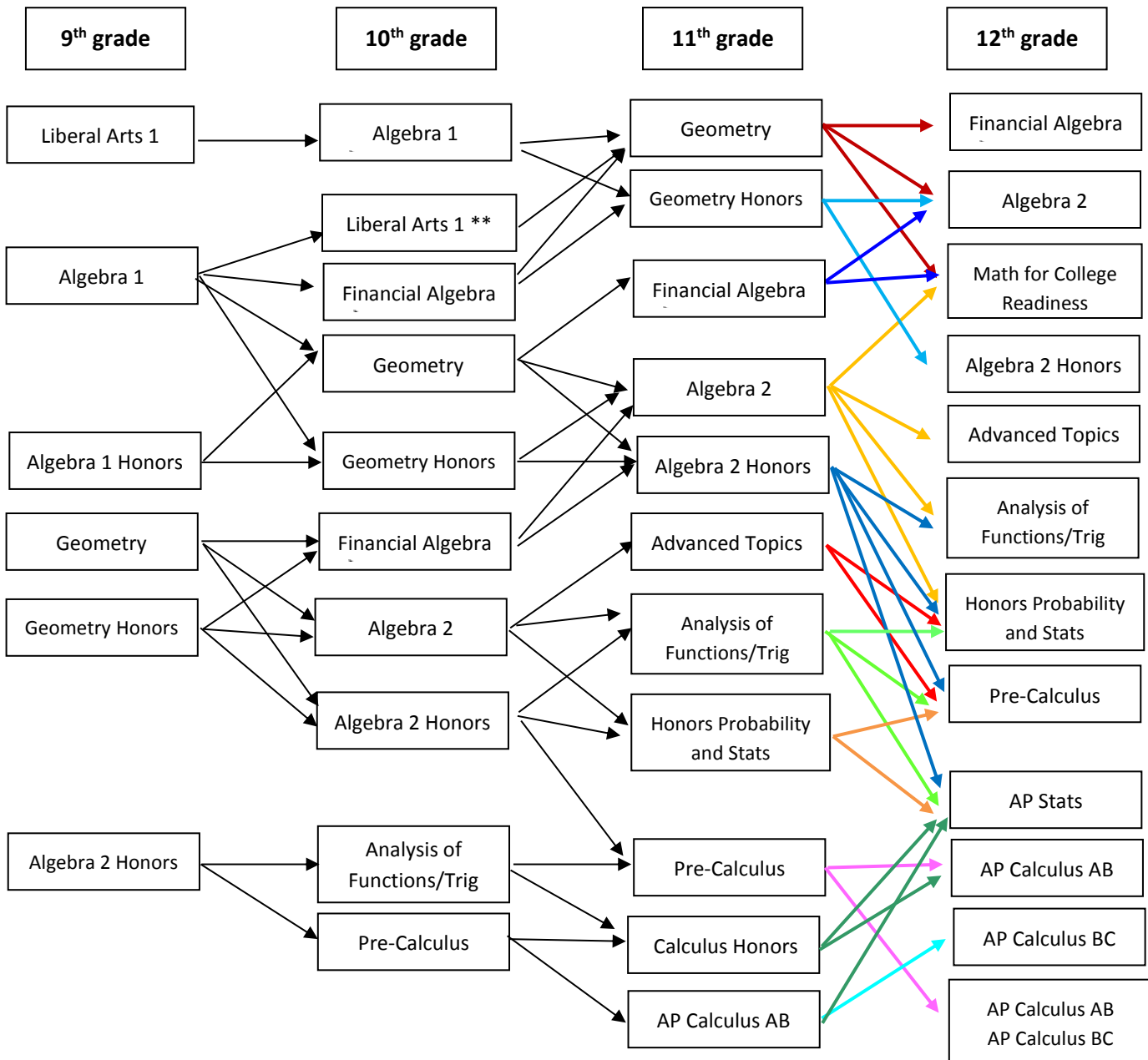


Broward County District HS Mathematics Course Flow Options 2018-2019

Below is the list of high school courses available for the 2017-2018 school year. In determining four year paths through these courses for students, schools should set course scheduling parameters and simplify the flow chart based on their student population and course offerings. Remedial courses may need to be doubled up if students are to satisfy graduation requirements within 4 years.



NOTE: The flowchart above is intended to indicate normal sequences of courses for senior high school students. It is not a system for tracking. For example, a student who begins the sequence with Algebra 1 could take Geometry Honors the following year, based on performance and teacher recommendation. Also, Liberal Arts 1 and Financial Algebra are not yet recognized by NCAA (check with your school) but have been approved by Bright Futures and SUS admissions. Students cannot receive Bright Futures credit for both AP Statistics and Probability & Statistics with Applications Honors. **Please refer to the Counseling for Future Education Handbook for a list of eligible Math courses.**

** Liberal Arts 1 in the 10th grade is for students who score a level 1 or low 2 on Algebra 1 EOC in 9th grade. All students should take Geometry by 11th grade.
