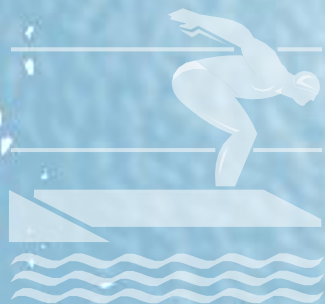

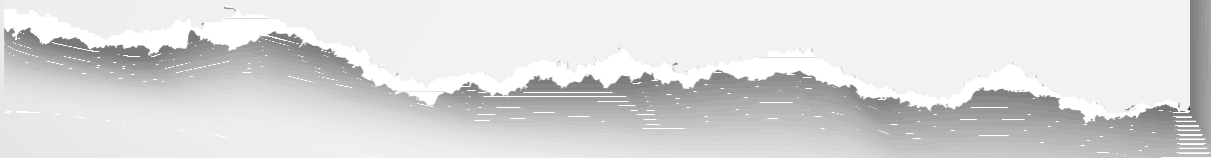

CRITERIA FOR SCHOLAR ATHLETE AWARD

- Must have a minimum of a 3.2 G.P.A., including the first semester of the senior year;
- Must be a varsity letter winner;
- Must exhibit commitment to total school program and community at large;
- Must be nominated by the high school principal.



BCAA North County Coach of the Year

Cardinal Gibbons girls' soccer coach Margo Flack had to be thinking, "when would a state championship ever become reality."

That time finally came in February.

Flack, a soccer player herself and graduate of Gibbons won her first state title in her 21st year as coach with a 2-0 victory over Arnold (Panama City) for the Class 4A championship.

The win was the 328th of her career and that earned her the Broward County Athletic Association's North County Coach of the Year.

The Chiefs finished the 2021 campaign at 12-2-1, that included a nine-game winning streak. The season also included a pair of victories over American Heritage.

The championship was well-earned after being a three-time state runner. The first came in 2009, while the others were 2019-20.

"Coach Flack's lifelong commitment to Cardinal Gibbons High School and the soccer program was rewarded with a well-deserved State Championship this past February," said Cardinal Gibbons Athletic Director Mike Morrill. "The girls played with intensity and grace which is a direct influence of Mrs. Flack's coaching style. In fact, all her teams through the years have been a mirror reflection of her."

Prior to Flack's first state title as coach, the Chiefs had earned 11 district titles under her leadership. Her career record entering next season is 328-115-52, which is just shy of a 75-percent winning percentage.

BCAA South County Coach of the Year

For 13 seasons Phil Schmalz has guided the Cooper City High softball team through numerous winning seasons. The 2021 campaign for a Class 6A state title has been no different. Schmalz and his team have been focused on winning the first state championship since his first season in 2009. At 18-4 following a 10-1 victory over South Plantation for the District 1-6A title, the Cowboys are very capable.

Schmalz, who began coaching softball when his daughter began playing the sport, has built his team into one of Broward's best and has been named the Broward County Athletic Association's Southern Division Coach of the Year For 2021.

"Schmalz has been either District Champs or runner up every year he has been with us except one," said Cooper City Athletic Director Paul Megna. "The Big 8 win was huge! It could be what puts us over the top. Beating Coral Springs Charter made it even better since they are and have been one of the best programs in the state."

The 7-5 victory over Charter in the Big 8 Final was impressive and proved they can beat the best. The Cowboys also defeated Palm Beach Gardens in extra innings in the final regular season game.

The victory over Charter snapped the Panthers two-year tourney reign in the Big 8. The loss also marked the end of a 186-game streak where Coral Springs Charter had not lost a game when allowing seven or more runs. Strangely, Cooper City was the last team to do so when they defeated the Panthers 10-3 on Mar. 8, 2014.

Cooper City has scored 10 or more runs in six games this season and defeated five teams that participated in the Big 8 tourney.

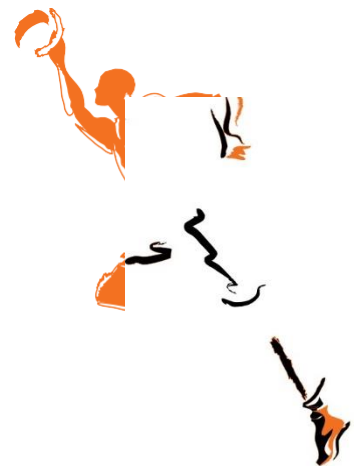
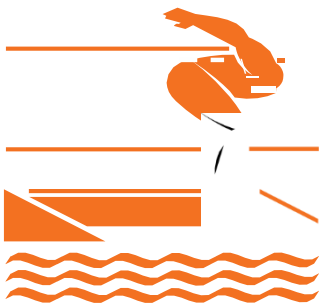
