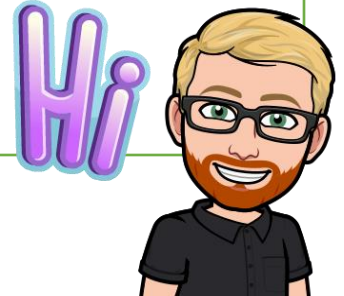
You do not need any experience to be a member of the Debate Team.

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Debate Categories

Original Oratory

Original Oratory is a speech written by the student with the intent to inform or persuade the audience on a topic of importance to them.

Your goal is to persuade the audience and judges to agree with your view of the topic you present.

Congressional

Congressional Debate is a simulation of the U.S. legislative process in the Senate and the House of Representatives. Students will be given two bills and possible resolutions in which they will deliver a speech for or against the topic.

The goal is to persuade the audience and judges to agree with your arguments.

Interpretation

Interpretation uses a selection or selections of any literature (prose, poetry, drama, etc.) that has been published. The literature you choose to perform can be topics that are serious, humorous, or thought provoking.

Your goal is to be a dramatic storyteller and create a performance that will leave the audience and the judges wanting more.



Impromptu

In Impromptu you are given a random quote at the start of the competition. You will then explain, elaborate, and expand information about the quote.

Your goal is to teach, persuade, and entertain to the audience and judges.
