Country Hills Important Information

- The First Day of School is Monday, August 12th
- School Hours: 8:10 AM 2:10 PM
- Office Phone Number: 754-322-5950

Arrival Procedure: Students are welcome on campus at 7:40 AM. Supervision will not be available prior to 7:40 AM. Students may be dropped off at Car Loop A (off Coral Springs Drive) or Car Loop B (off Westview Drive) in the morning. We prefer our younger Rising Stars come through Car Loop A, which has more support and guidance to help students get to their classroom. For safety reasons, we will not allow any cars to drop off in the bus loading zone this year. Breakfast is available for all students free of charge, and students can go to the café as soon as they arrive on campus to eat. Students in K-3 will go to the hallway and sit by the classroom door until 8:05 AM. Students in 4th and 5th grade will go to the cafeteria in the morning and will be dismissed to their classrooms at 8:05 AM. Students will begin learning promptly at 8:10 AM. For our kindergarten families, you may walk your kindergartener to the door of the classroom for the first two days of school. We ask that you drop them at the door and do not go into the classroom. This makes the transition easier for both of you! The third day of school is Independence Day! Students will walk to class with the assistance of our older Rising Stars.

Dismissal Procedure:

- Car Riders: Students in K-2 are dismissed from Car Loop A off Coral Springs Drive in the afternoon, and students in grades 3-5 are dismissed at Car Loop B off Westview Drive. Older siblings in grades 3-5 must join younger siblings in Car Loop A for safety. Please be sure to display your Curbanatt number on your rearview mirror for our staff to see. You will receive the number at Meet and Greet. When a staff member enters the number into the system, it signals your child to come to the car loop at that time. By the time you pull around, your child will be outside and waiting for you. Please be patient for the first few days. The process goes quicker once everyone is familiar with the procedure. We will not be able to have any cars in the bus loading zone this year for safety. All students that get picked up by car must be picked up in Car Loop A or B.
- Walk-Up: If you will be walking up to pick up your child, you will need your Curbsmatt number as well. Walk-up is located at the bike rack between Car Loop A and Car Loop B. A staff member will open the gate at 2:10 PM and begin taking numbers. Students will exit campus through that gate. Parents are not allowed to enter the car loop on foot at any time. This is for safety and security.
- Private Aftercare: If your child takes a bus or van to their private aftercare facility, you
 must notify the school prior to the first day of school. We cannot dismiss students to
 another entity without parental permission.

A Few Tips: Just a reminder that when you are in the car loop, pull all the way forward and remain in your vehicle. We ask that you do not use your cell phone when you are in the loop, as we need your full attention while we load and unload 800 students. The more cars we can fit in the loop, the more students we can unload in the morning and load in the afternoon! If you pick up multiple students, you may put all the numbers on one car hanger.



BACK-TO-SCHOOL FORMS PARENT INFORMATION



- · The Back-to-School forms will be in Parent Portal for the primary parent/guardian.
- The forms WILL BE required the first time that parents log into the Parent Portal starting August
 1st.
- However, for parents who have filled out the forms in paper format, there will be a field on the student's record the IMT can select to indicate the BTS forms have been processed.
- This will remove the requirement for that student's parent to fill out the online forms.
- Our goal is to get as many parents as possible to utilize the online forms to ensure complete, accurate, and updated information in the system.
- · Back-to-school forms can be completed in the Parent Portal AND the BCPS Connect App




LOCATING BUS ROUTE ON FOCUS PARENT PORTAL






Sign Up Instructions for Parents:

- 1. Download Here Comes the Bus app or visit: www.herecomesthebus.com
- 2. Click "Sign Up", then click "Continue".
- 3. Click "I have the Code".
- Enter your email address, First Name, Last Name and School District Code (87599). Accept the Terms and Conditions, then click "Continue".
- 5. Press Confirm the district displayed is "Broward County Public Schools".
- 6. Create your password. Repeat your password. Press "Confirm Password" on the screen when complete.
- If successful, you will be directed to the Thank You screen. At that time, please check your email inbox for an email from <u>noreply@synovia.com</u>.
- Open this email and click the "Activate My Account" link. Once completed, close the browser. You
 may now open the app and sign in with your email address and newly created password.

Adding a Student:

- 1. Access the Here Comes the Bus app.
- 2. Click the Student icon.
- 3. Click the Add Student button, then enter their last name and Student ID. Click Submit.
- 4. Repeat this process for additional students.

Westview Drive Sidewalk Improvement Project

Project Overview:

As part of the annual sidewalk replacement program, the city is replacing the existing sidewalks along Westview Drive between Riverside Drive and Coral Ridge Drive and upgrading the ADA ramps. Work is expected to be completed in Spring 2025.

Project Scope:

The contractor anticipates starting work on the North portion of the Westview Drive Right-of-Way near Riverside Drive in Phase 1, and progress to the South side near Coral Ridge Drive for Phase 2. Work will consist of creating a wider, 8-foot concrete sidewalk on the north side of Westview Drive, and replacing the asphalt sidewalk with a 5-foot concrete sidewalk on the south side. Along with sidewalk work, swales will be regraded as needed to ensure proper drainage.



Schedule:

Crews will be working Monday through Friday, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
