TITLE I & SIP Information

Each school has a School Advisory Council (SAC) comprised of parents, teachers, community members, school administrators, non-instructional support staff and other stakeholders who meet regularly to establish priorities, set annual objectives, and monitor action steps for school improvement. English as a Second Language

The mission of the ESOL program is for the students to be successful in school and using the English language. Therefore, the students exit the program when their goals have been met in conversational and academic English. The students take the ACCESS test each year in January. Based on those results, as well as teacher recommendations, we will determine if the student is ready to exit the program or not. Even after the student exits, we have monitors in place.

Tips From Our Math Coach, Mrs. Aversa!

Stay positive about math: Show enthusiasm and let your child know that math can be fun and enjoyable.

Emphasize growth: Encourage your child by reminding them that everyone can learn math with practice and perseverance.

Highlight the value of math: Help them see the importance of math in everyday life and different careers by sharing examples of how family members use math at work.

Model confidence: Avoid negative statements like "I was never good at math." Instead, express confidence in your abilities to reinforce a positive mindset.

Promote persistence: Teach your child that it's okay to struggle with difficult problems and encourage them to keep trying until they succeed.

Celebrate efforts and successes: Praise their hard work and join in their excitement when they solve problems or understand something new.
