DOES MY CHILD NEED EARLY STEPS?

If you or anyone close to your child has expressed concern about not reaching their milestones - talking, walking, playing, interacting with others - call Child Find to initiate a referral.

ELIGIBILITY

A multi-disciplinary team of professionals will evaluate your child to determine eligibility for services. They assess the following areas:

- *Adaptive (self-help, feeding, dressing)*
- *Cognition (learning & problem solving)*
- *Communication*
- *Gross & Fine Motor Skills (moving, grasping, coordination)*
- *Physical (hearing, vision & health)*
- *Social/Emotional (playing & interacting with others)*



SERVICES AVAILABLE

If eligible, services may include:

- *Assistive Technology Devices*
- *Audiology Services*
- *Family Education / Early Intervention Sessions*
- *Occupational, Physical & Speech Therapy*
- *Service Coordination*
- *Vision Services*
- *Other Individualized Services*

FEES

There is no income criteria or out of pocket expenses to families.
