





Coconut Creek Elementary Proposed K8 Reconfiguration

- Reconfigure Coconut Creek
 Elementary as a K-8 school
- Currently 367 6th-8th grade public school (BCPS + charter) students living in Coconut Creek ES boundary
 - 131 (35.7%) attend their assigned middle school
 - o 69 attend Margate Middle
 - 62 attend Lyons Creek Middle
 - 112 (30.5%) attend charter schools









Coconut Creek Elementary Enrollment and Capacity Usage

- Total Students Living In Boundary = 740
- In-Boundary Students Attending = 326
- Percent of Assigned Students
 Attending = 44.1%
- Out-of-Boundary Students = 146
- ESE Classes = 7
- Prekindergarten Classes = 0







Boundary Considerations

Consideration	
Impact on Enrollment	Coconut Creek Elementary current enrollment= 472 students/ 62.5% capacity usage; proposal would result increase enrollment by adding three grade levels
Impact on Feeder Patterns	No impact; middle school enrollment is a choice option
Impact on Neighborhood Integrity	Improves neighborhood integrity by allowing students to remain in their community from PreK through 12 th grade and beyond.
Impact on Distance to School	Improves distance to school for 6 th – 8 th grade students who currently have to travel to either Lyons Creek Middle or Margate Middle
Impact on School Diversity	Is not anticipated to impact diversity as 6 th - 8th grade students will matriculate from elementary grades at Coconut Creek Elementary
Impact on Students with Special Needs	Coconut Creek Elementary: 143 ESE students/ 7 ESE special programs
