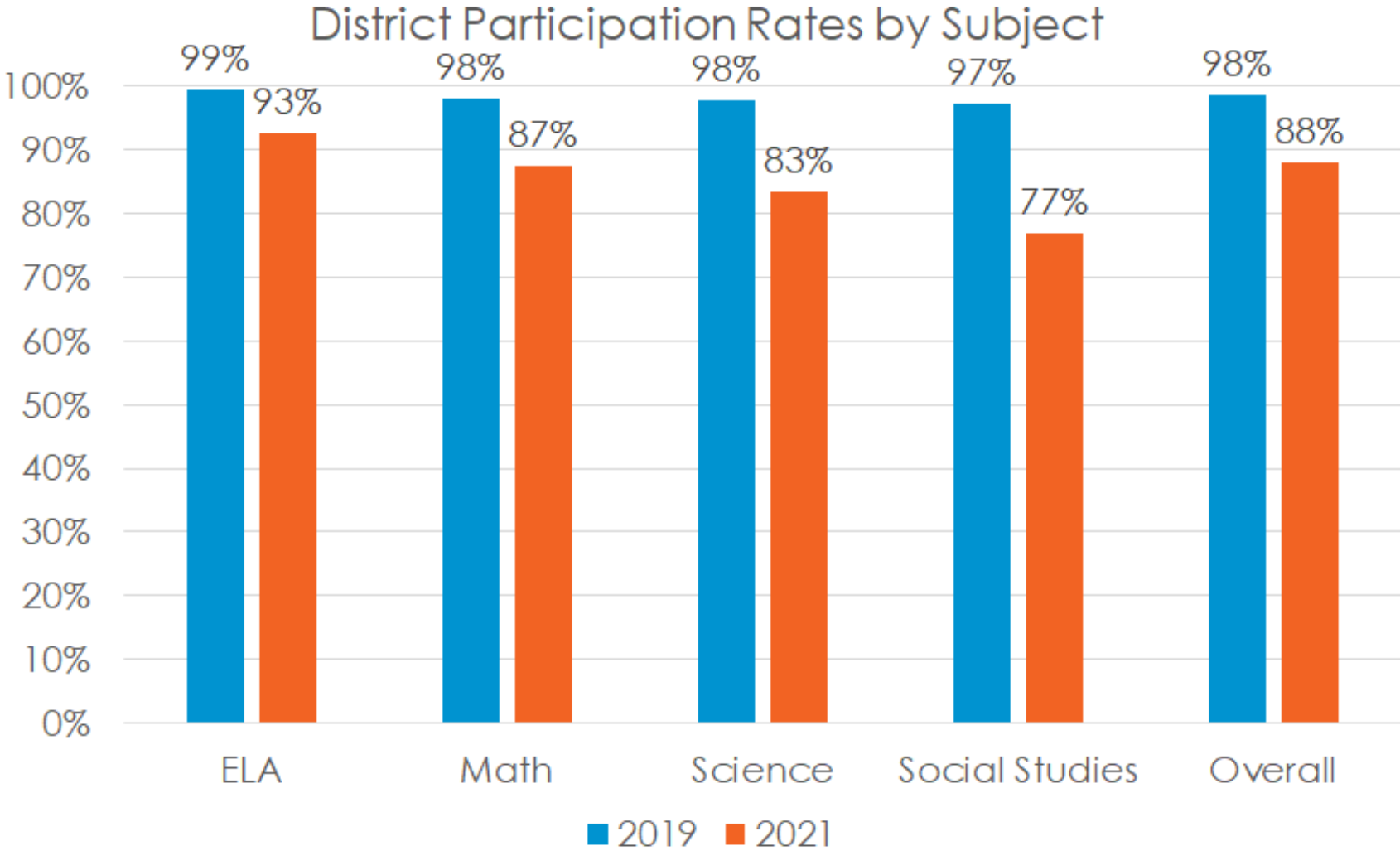

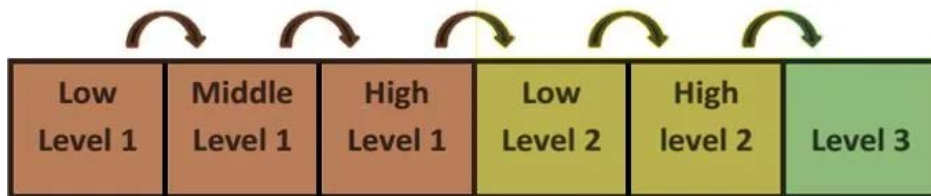
# Learning Gains in 2021



## Calculation of Learning Gains (All Students and the Low 25%)

### Current

- Learning gains are calculated based on the improvement from the prior year to the current year
- For example, a learning gain is measured based on improvement from the 2018 Grade 3 FSA ELA to the 2019 Grade 4 FSA ELA



### Adjustment for 2020-2021

- To accommodate the missing year of assessment results (2020), learning gains would be calculated based on the **improvement from the “prior-prior” year to the current year**
- For example, a learning gain would be based on improvement from the 2019 Grade 3 FSA ELA to the 2021 Grade 5 FSA ELA

# Eligibility for 2021 School & District Grade

Any school that tests **90 percent or more** of its **eligible** students, within 30 days (**August 30, 2021**) after the release of all state testing data, **may apply** to the State to **opt in** to have **2020-21 School Grades or School Improvement Ratings apply for all statutory purposes** that are associated with a school grade or rating.

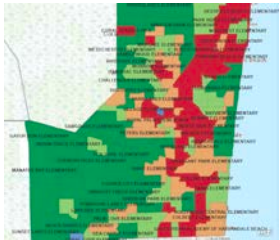
# Summary of FSA/EOC Results

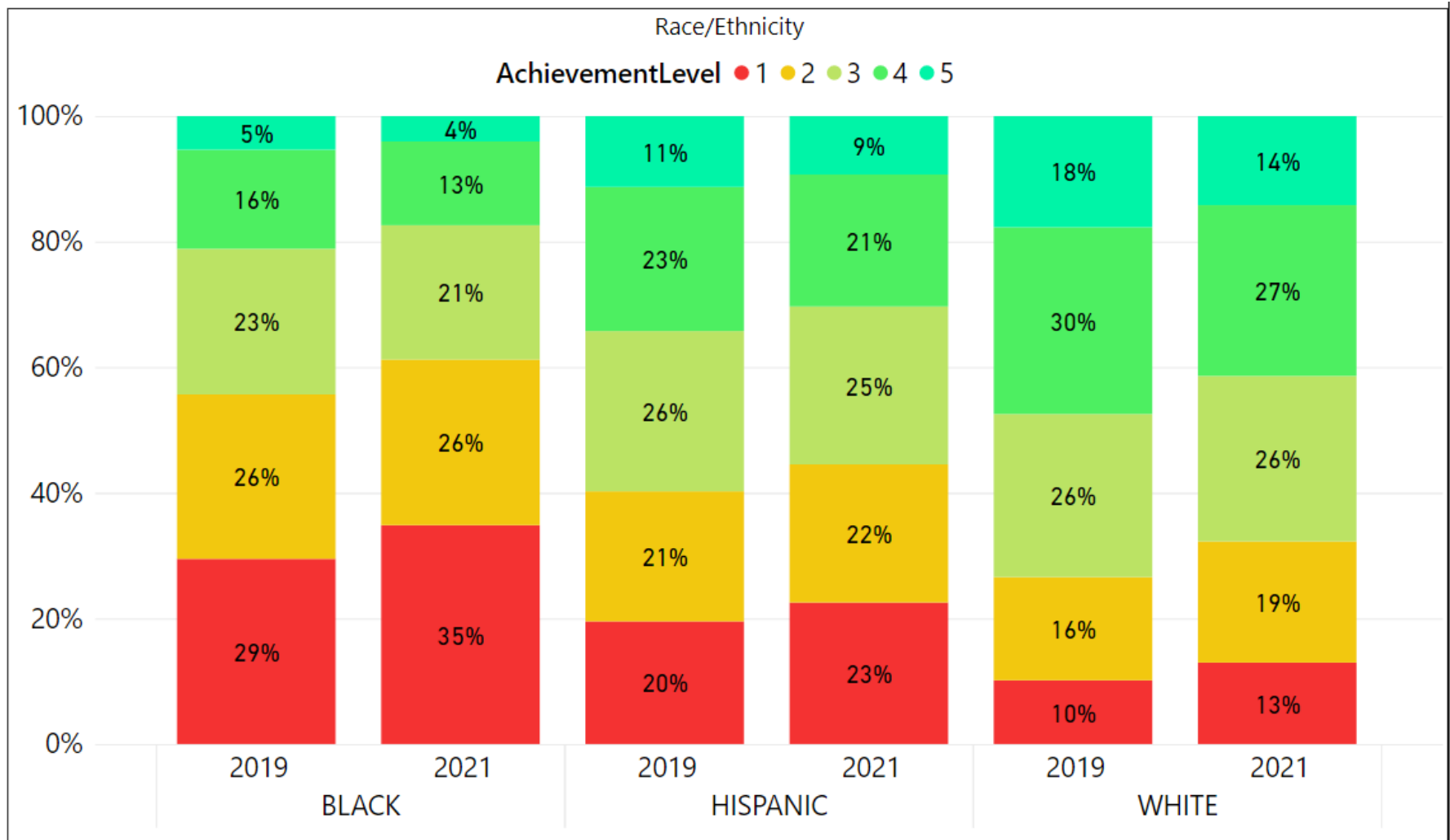

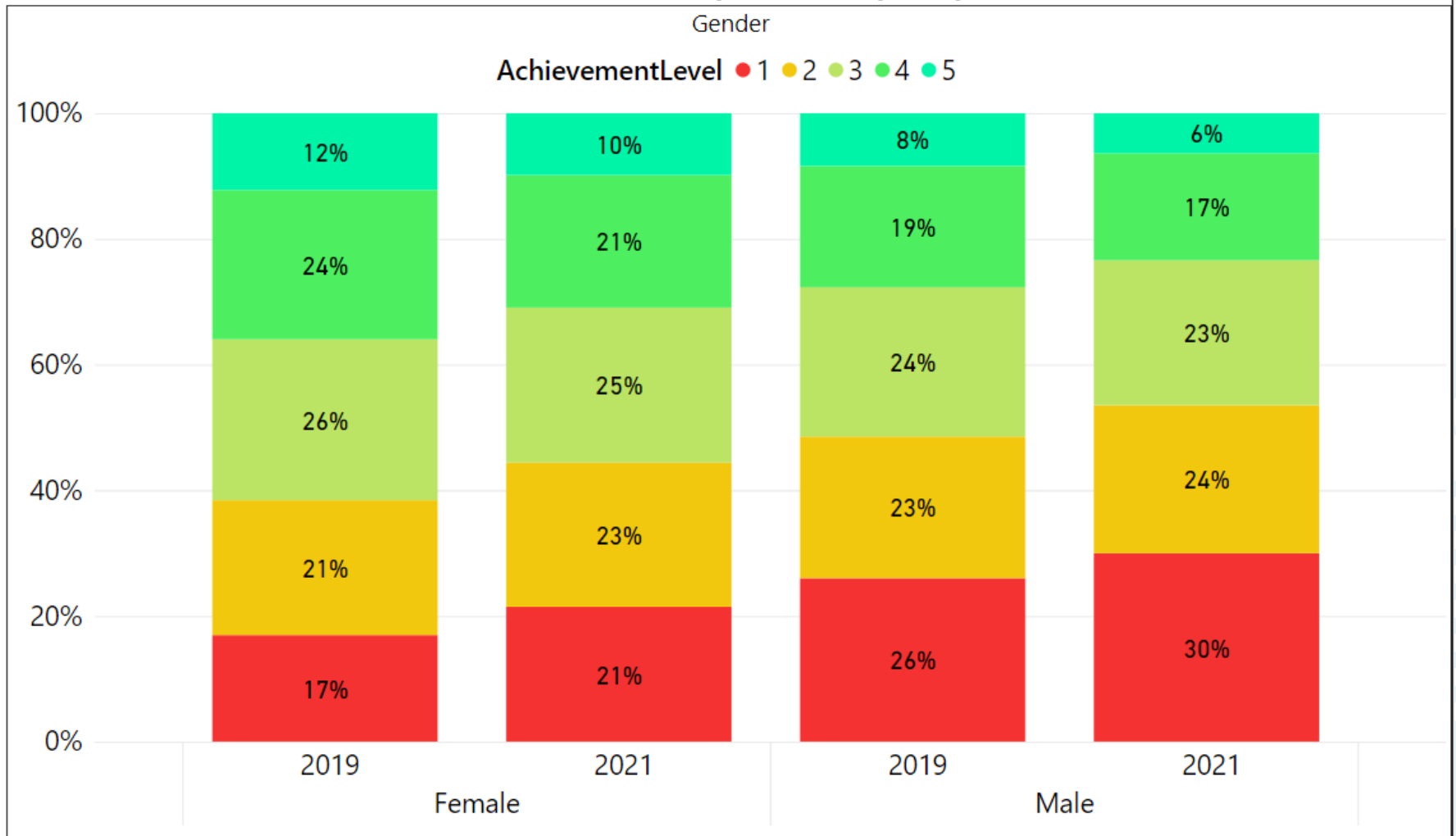

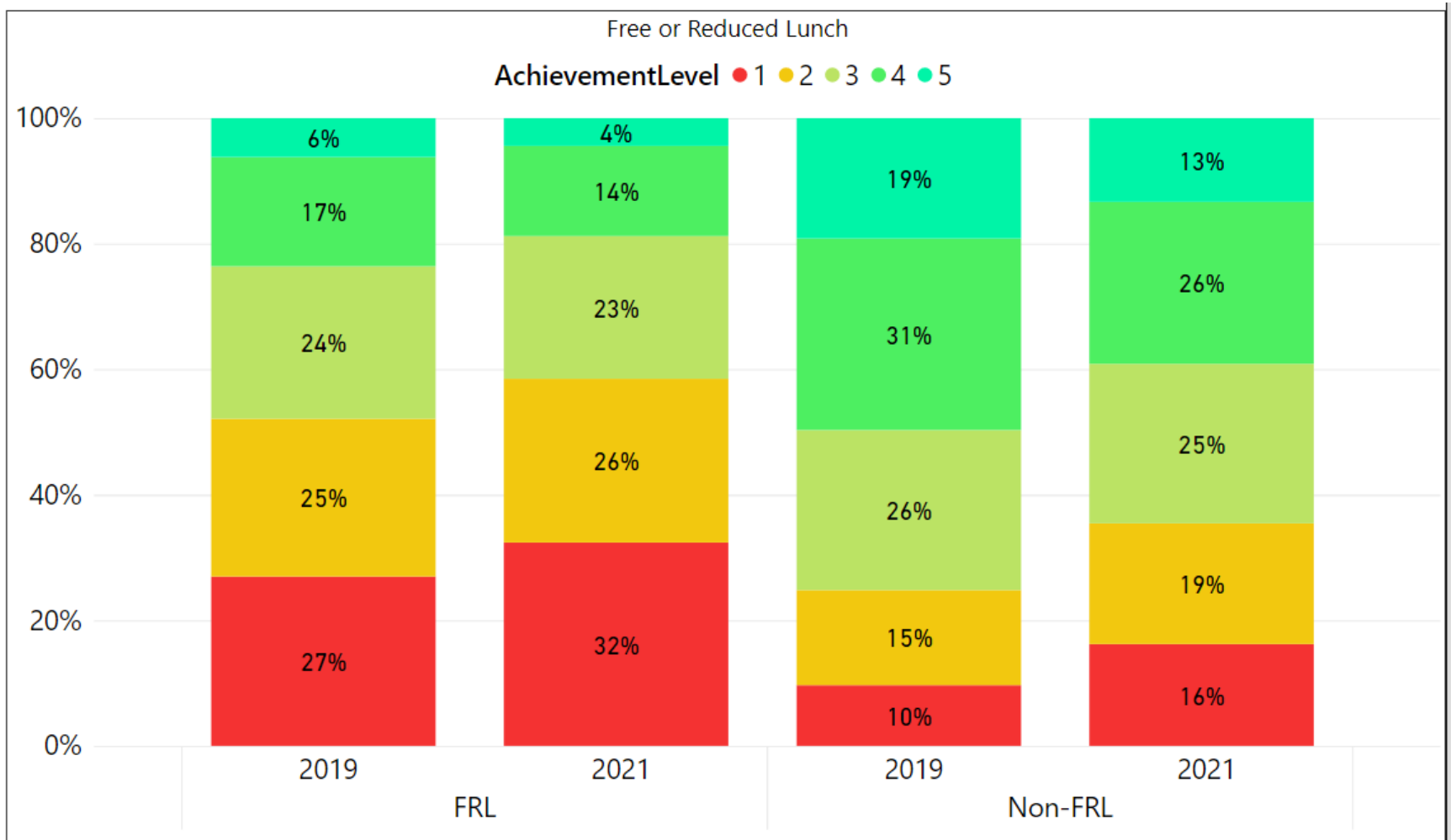

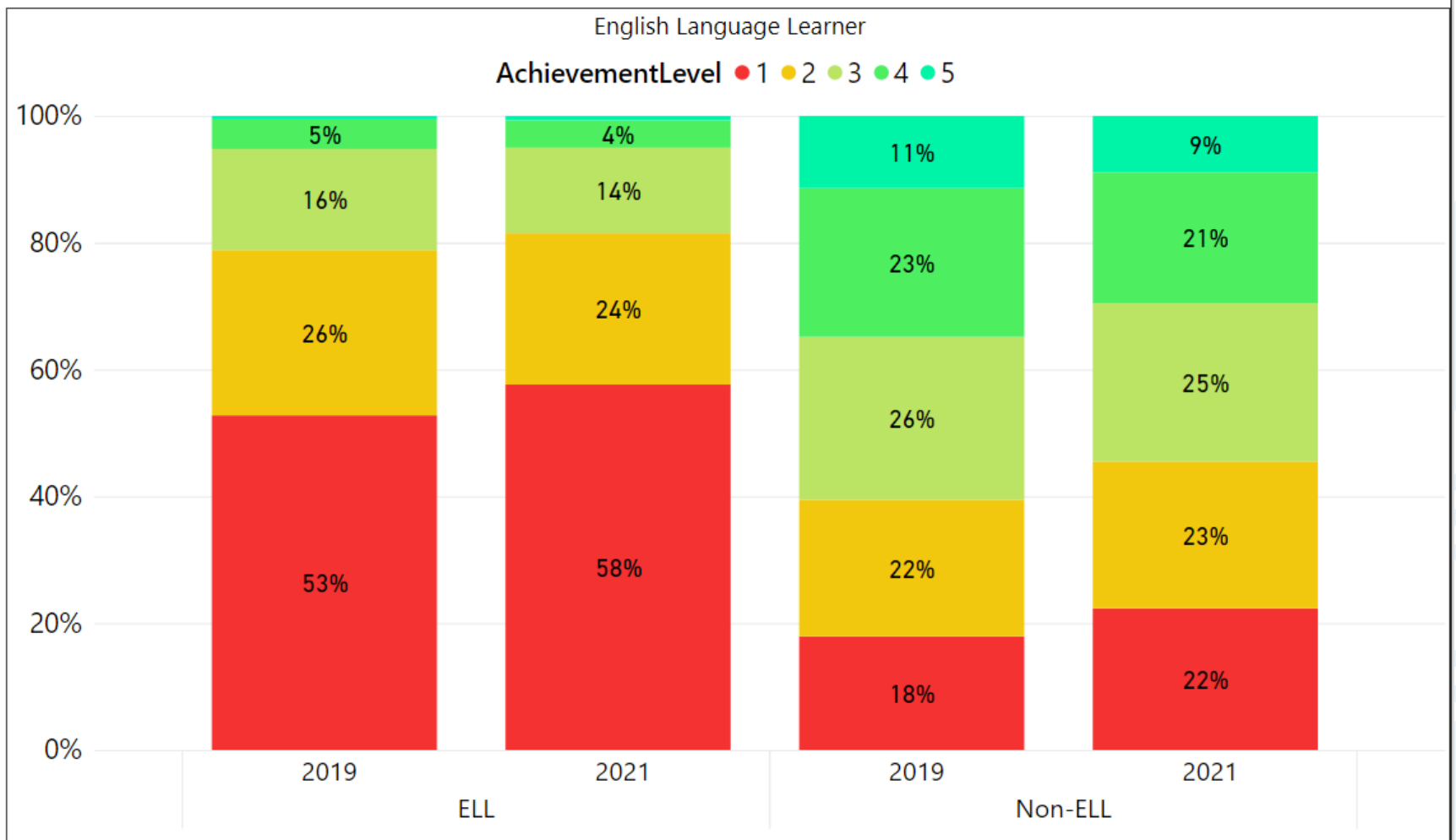

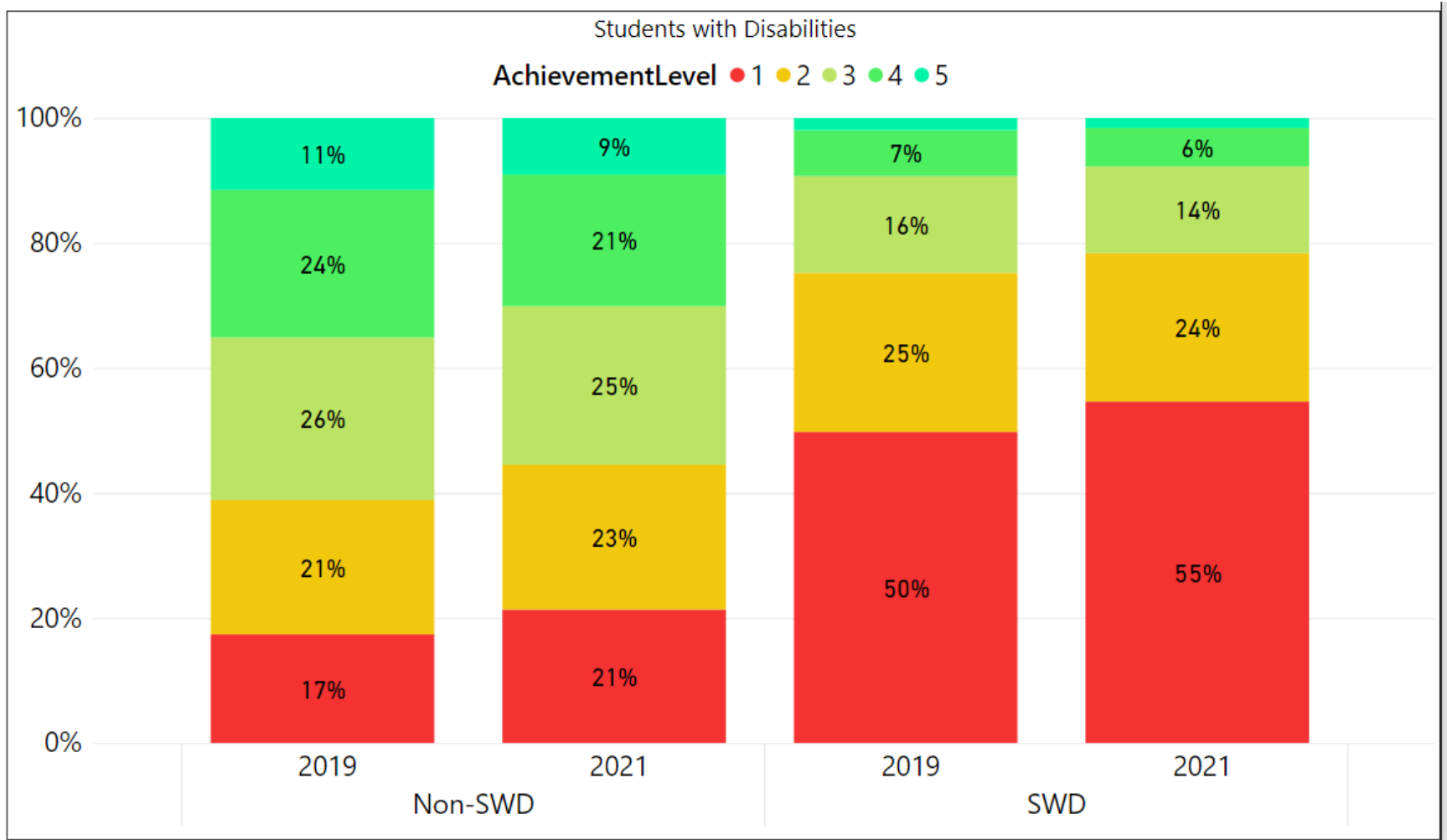

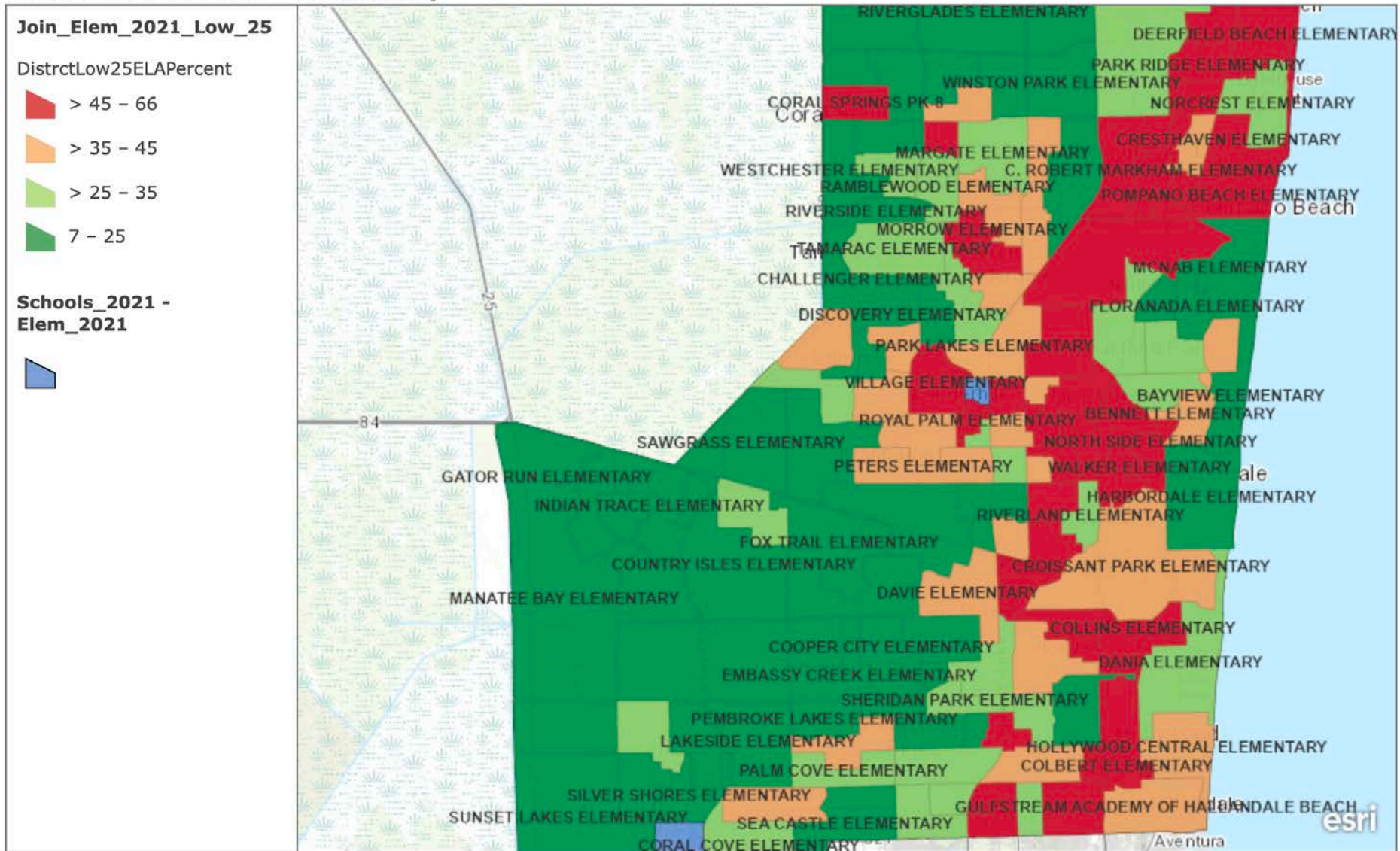

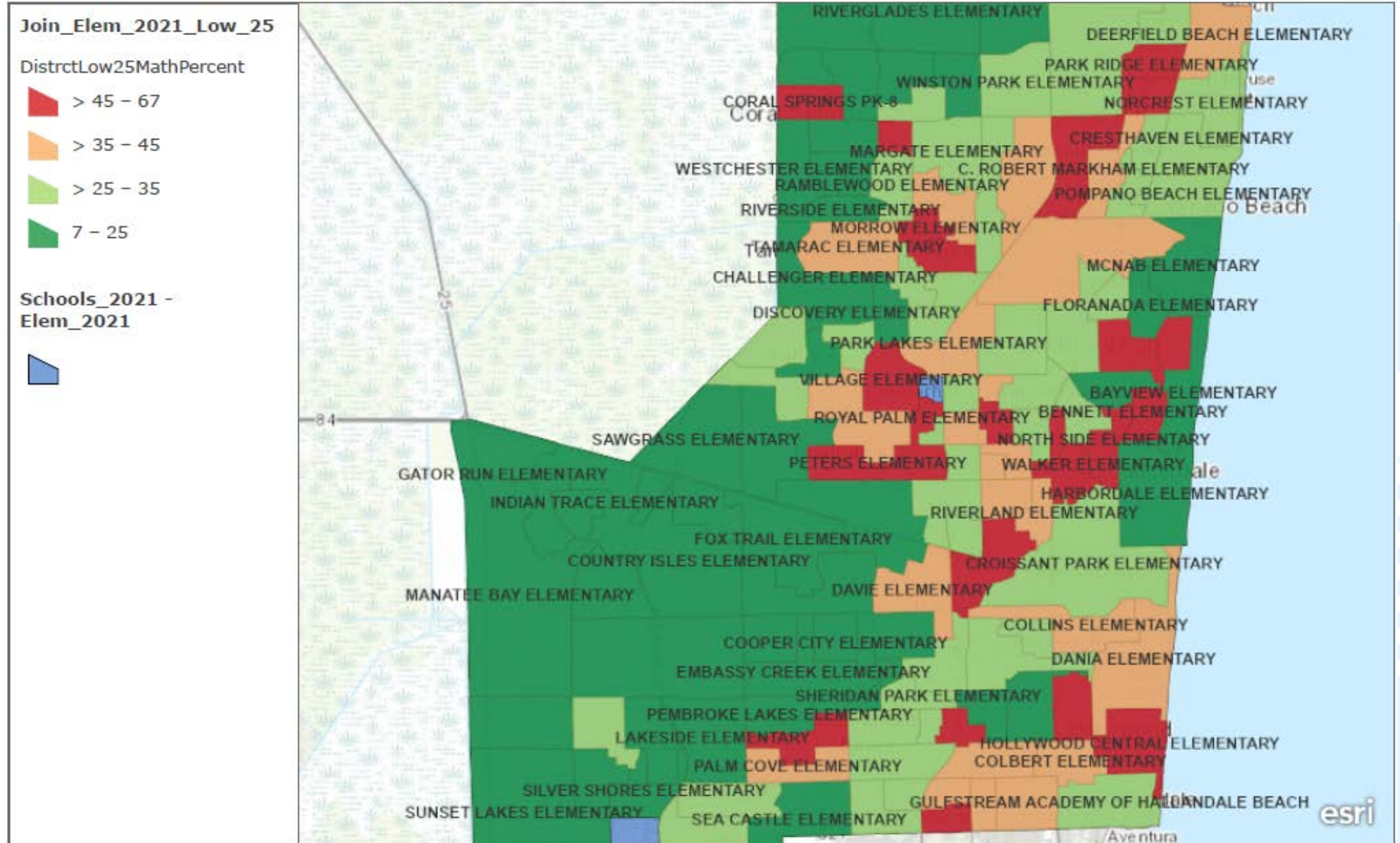
# District Lowest Performing Quartile: Elementary ELA

## District Low 25 ELA - Elementary



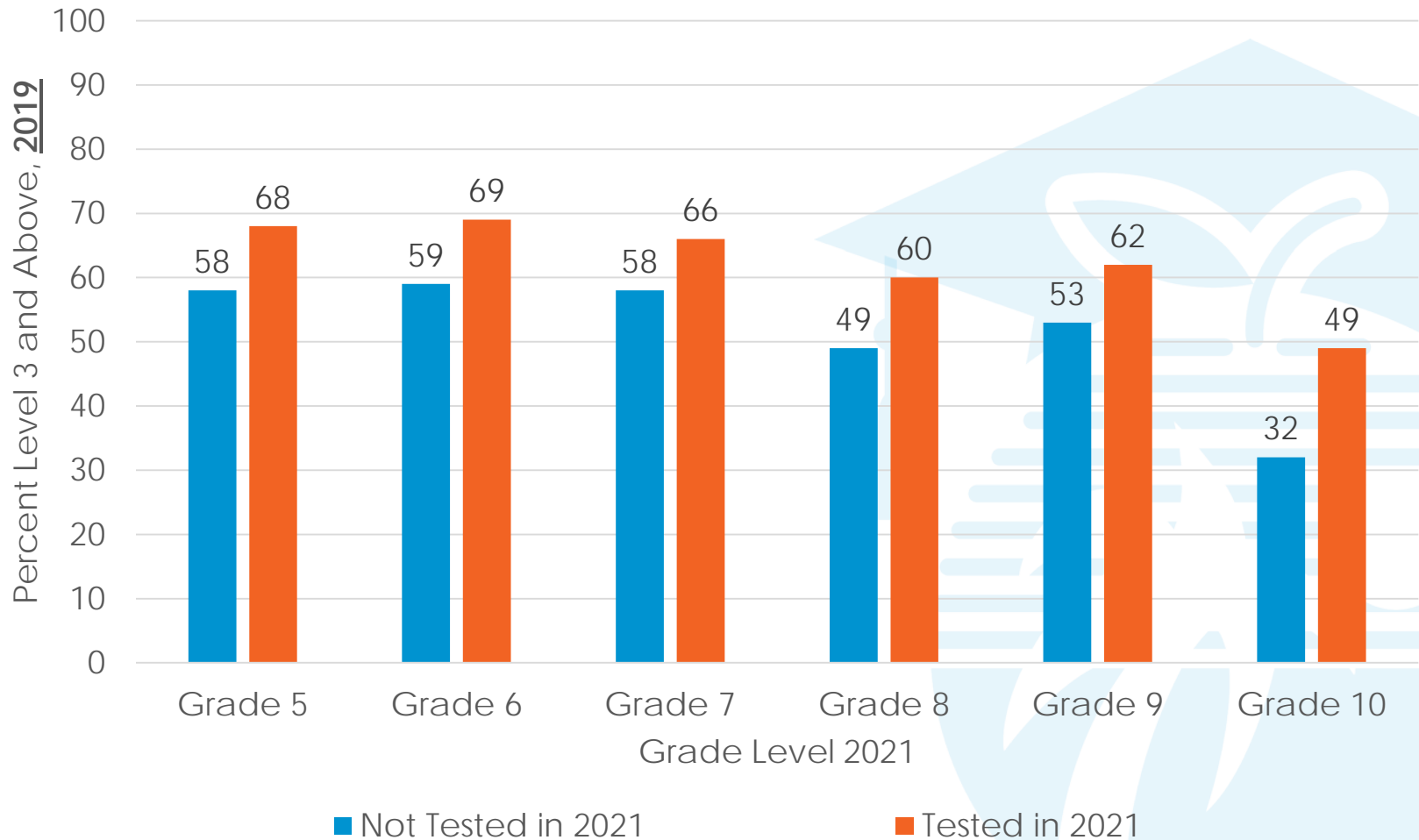
# District Lowest Performing Quartile: Elementary Math

## District Low 25 Math - Elementary

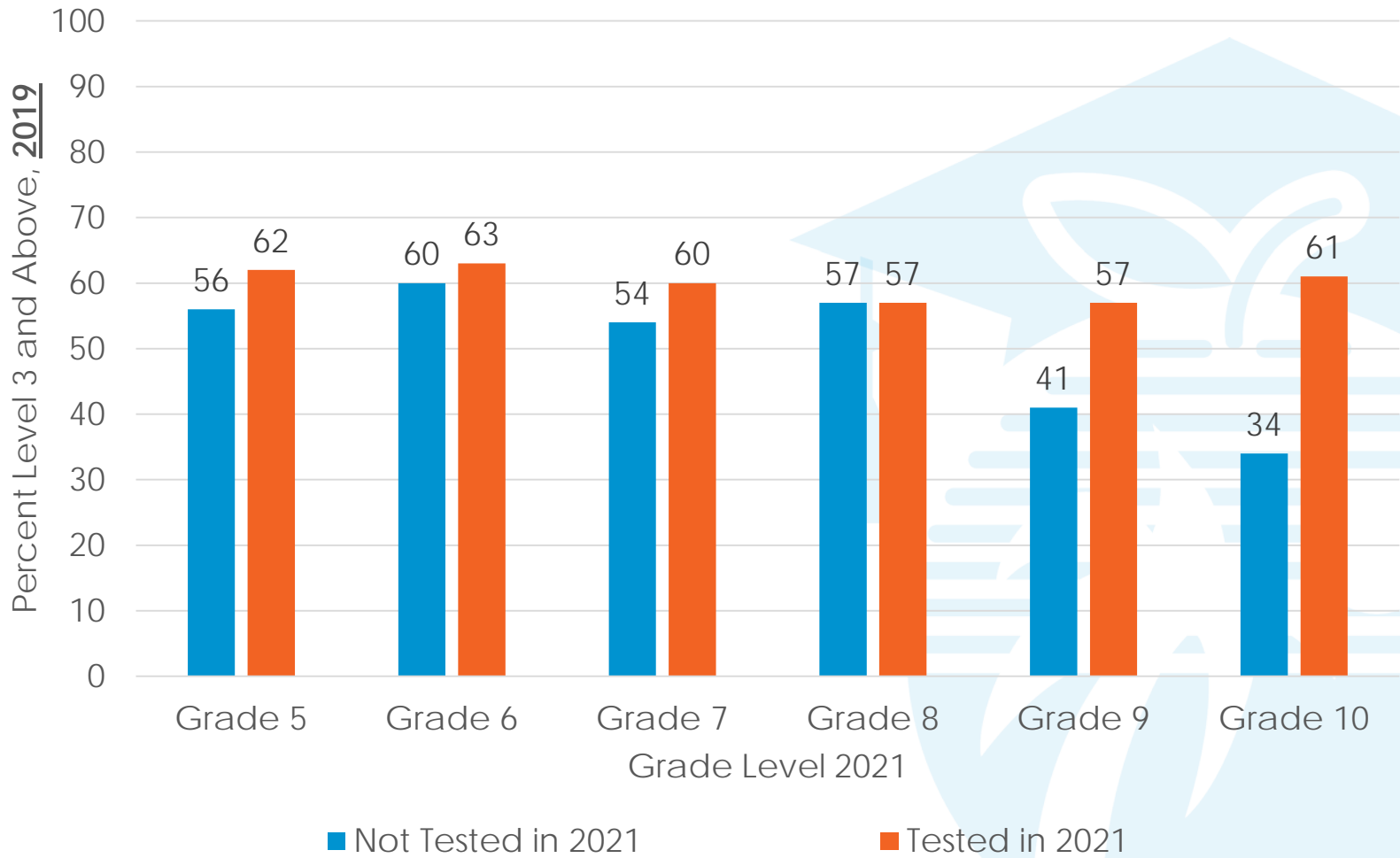




# Prior (2019) Performance vs. 2021 Test Status: Math
