SUBJECT: **HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATES, 2019-20** 

On January 7, 2021, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released Federal graduation rates for Florida and the 67 Florida school districts. State and district data are located online at the FDOE Education Information & Accountability Services Website:

The Chancellor of Public Schools, Jacob Oliva provided the following narrative due to circumstances related to the current pandemic, "While Florida's high school graduation rate increased by 3.1 percentage points over the last year to 90.0 percent in 2019-20, it is important to remember that pursuant to Florida Department of Education Emergency Order No. 2020-EO-1, students in the 2019-20 graduating class were exempt from statewide, standardized assessment requirements as stipulated in s. 1003.4282, F.S. Approximately 7.1% of the 2019-20 graduating class graduated with this exemption. It is possible that even with the opportunities to test or earn concordant scores last Spring, some of these students may not have ended up meeting the assessment graduation requirements. Therefore, one cannot definitely conclude that all of these students would have graduated if not provided the exemption. This uncertainty highlights the challenges in interpreting these results." In Broward, 9% (1,672 out of 17,757 graduates) of graduates received a standard diploma as a result of this exemption.

## Highlights from this data include:

- Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) achieved its highest graduation rate since Florida adopted the Federal Uniform Graduation Rate method in 2010-11.
- BCPS Federal graduation rate is 89.4% in 2019-20, which is an increase of 3.2 percentage points from 86.2% in 2018-19.
- BCPS traditional District high schools increased their graduation rate by 2.0% to 97.1% in 2019-20.
- Black (86.5%, 4.9 percentage point increase from 2018-19), Hispanic (90.0%, 3.1 percentage point increase from 2018-19), and White (92.4%, 0.8 percentage point increase from 2018-19) students improved their graduation rates. Black students registered a greater improvement in graduation rate, closing the gap with White students by 4.1 percentage points.
- The graduation rate gap between Free/reduced Price Lunch (FRL) and Non-FRL students narrowed to 6.3 percentage points and the gap for English Language Learner (ELL) and Non-ELL students narrowed by 10.8 percentage points to 2.8.

- The graduation rate gap between Free/reduced Price Lunch (FRL) and Non-FRL students narrowed to 6.3 percentage points and the gap for English Language Learner (ELL) and Non-ELL students narrowed by 10.8 percentage points to 2.8.
- 34 of 35 traditional District high schools achieved a graduation rate of 90% or higher and 30 of these schools reached a graduation rate at or above 95%.
- Five District high schools earned 100% graduation rates: Hallandale High School, Sheridan Technical High School, McFatter Technical High School, Lauderhill 6-12 and College Academy at Broward College. College Academy at Broward College achieved a graduation rate of 100% for the fifth consecutive year.
- Coconut Creek High School increased its graduation rate by 7.0 percentage points and Hallandale High School increased its graduation rate by 7.3 percentage points.
- Florida's Federal graduation rate is 90.0% in 2019-20, which is an increase of 3.1 percentage points from 86.9% in 2018-19.



Table 1 displays the historical graduation rates for Florida's five largest districts and the State overall. In 2019-20, Broward had a graduation rate of 89.4. For the past five years Broward's graduation rate has increased (from 78.7 in 2015-16 to 89.4 in 2019-20) representing a 10.7 percentage point increase.

Figure 1 illustrates the nine-year historical graduation rates for BCPS traditional District high schools, BCPS Strategic Plan (including high schools and centers), BCPS overall (including high schools, centers and charter schools), and Florida. BCPS traditional District high schools achieved graduation rates that were consistently higher than the state, reaching 97.1% in 2019-20.

Table 2 shows the graduation rates for the major race/ethnicity groups served in BCPS. The graduation rate increased for all three groups; with Black students showing a greater increase than their peers. In 2019-20, the gap between Black and White students narrowed by over four percentage points (4.1) and the gap between Hispanic and White students also showed a decrease by 2.3 percentage points compared to 2018-19.

Table 3 shows the graduation rates by special category groups served in BCPS. The graduation rate increased by 4.3 percentage points for students who are eligible for FRL, increased 1.4 percentage points for students with disabilities (SWD), and increased 12.9 percentage points for English Language Learner (ELL) students from 2018-19 to 2019-20.

The graduation rate gap between FRL and Non-FRL students narrowed to 6.3 percentage points and the gap for SWD and Non-SWD students widened to 6.2 percentage points. The graduation rate gap between ELL and Non-ELL students decreased by 10.8 percentage points to 2.8.

Appendix A shows the graduation rates for BCPS schools from 2015-16 through 2019-20. Review of the appendix shows that 34 of 35 traditional District high schools achieved a graduation rate of 90% or higher. Coconut Creek High School increased its graduation rate by 7.0 percentage points and Hallandale High School increased its graduation rate by 7.3 percentage points. College Academy at Broward College achieved graduation rate of 100% for the fifth consecutive year.

Appendix B shows the cohort size and graduation rates for the major race/ethnicity groups served in BCPS by school for the 2019-20 graduation cohort.

Appendix C shows the historical graduation rates for 2011-12 through 2019-20 for BCPS by schools.
