SUBJECT: HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATES, 2016-17

On January 10, 2018, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released Federal graduation rates for Florida and the 67 Florida school districts. State and district data are located online at the FDOE Education Information & Accountability Services Website:

Highlights from this data include:

- Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) achieved its highest graduation rate since Florida adopted the Federal Uniform Graduation Rate method in 2010-11.
- BCPS Federal graduation rate was **81.0% in 2016-17**, which is an increase of 2.3 percentage points from 78.7% in 2015-16.
- BCPS traditional high schools achieved a graduation rate of **93.8% in 2016-17**, which exceeded the 92.2% achieved in 2015-16.
- Black (75.0%, 4.4 percentage point increase from 2015-16), Hispanic (83.0%, 1.7 percentage point increase from 2015-16), and White (87.3%, 1.2 percentage point increase from 2015-16) students improved their graduation rates. Black students registered a greater improvement in graduation rate, closing the gap with White students by 3.2 percentage points.
- 31 of 34 traditional high schools had a graduation rate of 90% or higher.
- 24 of 33 traditional high schools improved or maintained their graduation rate (Lauderhill 6-12 did not have a graduation rate from the prior year).
- Coral Springs High School, Coconut Creek High School and Piper High School increased their graduation rate by five percentage points or more compared to 2015-16. Atlantic Technical College, Broward Virtual School, College Academy, and Lauderhill 6-12 achieved graduation rates of 100%.
- Florida's Federal graduation rate was 82.3% in 2016-17, which is an increase of 1.6 percentage points from 80.7% in 2015-16.

<u>Table 1</u> displays the historical graduation rates for Florida's five largest districts and the State overall. In 2016-17, Broward had a graduation rate of 81.0, which was higher than Miami-Dade but lower than Hillsborough, Orange, Palm Beach, and Florida. All of the big five districts increased their graduation rates by over two percentage points with the exception of Miami-Dade County.

<u>Figure 1</u> illustrates the six-year historical graduation rates for BCPS traditional high schools, BCPS overall (including centers and charter schools), and Florida. BCPS traditional schools achieved graduation rates that were consistently higher than the state, reaching 93.8% in 2016-17.

<u>Table 2</u> shows the graduation rates for the major race/ethnicity groups served in BCPS. The graduation rate increased for all three groups; however, Black students showed a greater increase than did their peers. In 2016-17, the gap between Black and White students decreased by 3.2 percentage points and the gap between Hispanic and White students was stable.

Appendix A shows the graduation rates for the five most recent cohorts attending Broward. Review of the appendix shows that 31 traditional high schools had a graduation rate of 90% or higher. Twenty-four of BCPS' traditional high schools improved or maintained their graduation rate. Coral Springs High School (increased 7.6 percentage points), Coconut Creek High School (increased 6.8 percentage points) and Piper High School (increased 5.0 percentage points) increased their graduation rate by five percentage points or more compared to 2015-16. Atlantic Technical College, Broward Virtual School, College Academy, and Lauderhill 6-12 achieved graduation rates of 100%.
